

World Cup Rules

- 20 minute running clock per game, no halftime
- All CSC modified FIFA Rules apply unless otherwise addressed in these Rules
- 3 field players + 1 keeper
- All kicks are indirect (5 yds given to kicker)
- Goal kicks and throws cannot pass mid-field without being touched by a player
- Goalie cannot punt
- No off-sides, no slide-tackling
- Players may enter the goal box to play the ball
- Re-starts from sideline can be kick-ins or throw-ins
- Goals can be scored from anywhere on the attacking half of the field.
- Goals can not be scored directly by a team from their defensive half of the field.
- Goals can not be scored directly from kick-offs, free kicks, kick-ins or goal kicks unless the ball is touched by any player on the attacking half of the field.
- Once the kick is taken, if any player (attacker or defender) touches the ball in the attacking half of the field and the ball goes in the goal, a goal is awarded to the attacking team.
