Approval of Minutes from the September Meeting: Motion to approve by Brock Barton. Seconded by Allison Mancuso. Motion passed to approve the minutes.

Age Group Updates

- a. 14u - Brock reports that 14u is going through eval round 2. He feels it's going well so far, one skate in. The communication about the process has gone over well so far and he feels we have set a good precedent with our model.
- b. 12u - Will said that 12u is one session in so far. He is going to do the same model as 10u with skills stations on Mondays. Thursdays will be 2-3 group drills and then team break outs . There is one 12U trying out this week being evaluated.
- c. 10u - Jen said that night one was great for 10U. Dave designed practice to have lots of puck touches and short lines. The coaches put a lot of work into planning in the off season and it showed. 12U is going to follow this model.
- d. 8u - Allison reports they have had one house and travel practice so far. It felt a bit chaotic for the first night from a coaching standpoint and they have suggestions for improvement for night two. The feedback from kids and parents was that they had a blast.

BBQ- The BBQ was highly attended. Will said we received praise from Bob at Stateline. He wants to get Bauer/CCM people there for next year. We also need a bigger grill next year to prevent long food lines. Two small grills wasn't enough for the amount of people we had.
