POOL PLAY TIEBREAKER

SPECIAL NOTE REGARDING FORFEITS



- All forfeits are scored 15-0.
- If a team plays in a pool play format and forfeits any game, they will be automatically determined to be the last place team in their pool regardless of win/loss record and/or point differential.

TWO-TEAM TIE In any situation where two teams are tied, head-to-head competition between the teams shall determine the winner.

THREE OR MORE TEAMS TIED

Step One: A point differential tiebreaker will be applied if more than two teams are tied. The point differentials of the teams involved in the tie are totaled. Teams are then ranked according to the sum of the point differential, and the team with the highest ranking is determined as the pool play winner. (Regardless of actual game scores, 15 points is the maximum plus or minus total that will be factored into the point differential calculation.) NOTE: Once the pool winner has been determined via the point differential, the tie between the remaining two teams shall be broken based on head-to-head competition.
