NEWS & NOTES

- ★ Indy Eleven will look to improve upon its 4W-2L-0D record against Sporting Kansas City II, a series that began in 2019 after the “artist formerly known as Swope Park Rangers” jumped to the USL Championship’s Eastern Conference.
- ★ Last year’s four-game series – contested entirely at Lucas Oil Stadium – was split down the middle, with each squad alternating hard-fought, one-goal victories during the condensed calendar. Indy captured a pair of 2-1 victories on July 18 and Sept. 9, with Paddy Barrett and Jeremy Rafanello bagging second half game-winners, respectively.
- ★ Meanwhile, SKC earned one of the shock results of the Championship season on Aug. 1, their 1-0 triumph snapping the second-longest home undefeated (28 games) and winning (11 games) streaks in USL Championship history. SKC’s 2-1 victory over the Eleven on Sept. 30 was also a memorable one – but for the wrong reason, as it denied the Boys in Blue an opportunity to clinch a postseason berth in their penultimate game of the regular season.
- ★ Of the 16 newcomers to the Indy Eleven roster over the offseason, 12 have already made their debut. Eleven Boys in Blue got their first minutes with the squad in the 1-0 season opening win at Birmingham on May 1 (A.J. Cochran, Rece Buckmaster, Aboubacar Sissoko, Nicky Law, Gershon Koffie, Patrick Seagrist, Manuel Arteaga, Cammy Smith, Jeremiah Gutjahr, Jared Timmer, and Jordan Hamilton), while Gordon Wild came off the bench on May 8 vs. FC Tulsa to mark his debut in blue.

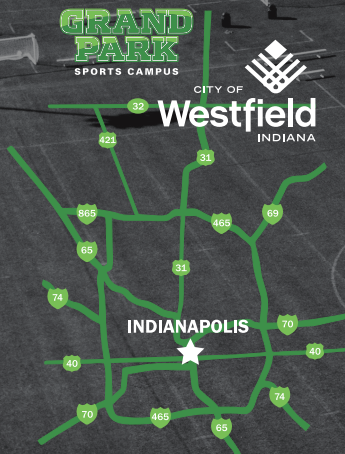

Guiding Principles

Create a safe stadium environment for our fans by adhering to federal, state, and local guidelines relating to the COVID-19 pandemic with specific focus on the following strategic elements.

1. Social Distancing – mitigating key congregation points to ensure the maintenance of social distancing wherever possible.
2. Minimal Contact – institute strategies that reduce physical contact points with people and surfaces.
3. Cleanliness – ensure focus on routine cleaning of high-volume touch areas such as handrails and common surfaces.
4. Participant Safety – mitigating risk to players, coaches, officials, and spectators.

Ticketing

Ticket License – Indy Eleven game tickets will have updated language to include: A waiver for risks associated with Covid-19 covering the Indy Eleven and IUPUI.

All ticketing will be reserved seating to start the season.

- Will use lower level-sections (0-18), mid-level sections (101-117), upper-level sections (206-212), and seating behind west goal.
- Seats will be sold in small groups of 1-6 seats and will be separated from surrounding seats by appropriate social distancing.
- Groups will be staggered to ensure a minimum of one full row between groups immediately in front or behind a group to ensure 6 feet of social distance.

Box Office

- Guest and media will call and game day ticket purchase options will continue to take place at the box office which is protected by glass.
- All box office lines will have marked guidelines for fans to maintain social distancing during purchase.
- All lines will be at least six feet apart and will be marked on the ground.

Suites

- Suites will be sold at a limited capacity.
- Seats will be assigned to ensure social distancing.
- Guests will be required to wear mask; exception will be while actively eating or drinking.

Parking

No tailgating will be permitted to start the 2021 season.

Parking will open 90 minutes prior to door openings to mitigate any opportunity for tailgating.

Prepaid parking will be encouraged, alternatively credit cards and cash will be accepted.

Parking Lots A, B, & C will be open for spectators.

Parking Lot A will be in use by Indy Eleven staff and vendors during pregame setup.

Indy Eleven Players/Trainers/Team personnel will park in the IUPUI Sports Garage connected to the Natatorium.

Parking services provider will have additional staff to marshal the parking of vehicles in each lot to ensure social distancing.

All parking attendants will be required to wear face masks.

Attendants will screen for parking passes at each open gate.

Guests will be required to show their pre-paid pass to the attendant, all attendants will maintain social distancing and the Guest will be required to present the pass behind a closed window.

Stadium Entry/Exit and Security

Fan Ingress

- All fans will be encouraged to enter the gate designated on their ticket, which will correspond to their seating location.
 - GATE A (Northeast Gate)
 - Sections 5-10
 - Sections 101-110
 - Sections 206-210
 - GATE B (Suite Holder Gate)
 - All Hospitality Tent and Suite Ticket Holders
 - GATE C (Northwest Gate)
 - Sections 11-18
 - Sections 111-117
 - Sections 211-212

- All fans who require a ticket (aged 4 years or older) will be required to wear self-provided cloth or medical masks at all times inside the stadium except for when eating or drinking.

- East and West gates will be open for entry.

- Guest entry lines will be marked every 6 feet to mark the social distancing queues.

- Bike rack chutes will be utilized to guide guests during the entry process.

- Signage will be posted at all gates that reads, "Any fans that have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19, are experiencing a loss of taste or smell, cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat should not attend the match and should contact Indy Eleven customer service via phone or e-mail the next business day to seek a ticket exchange".

The first of three parts of spectator entry to the stadium will be a health/temperature checkpoint.

- A security gameday employee will verbally ask each fan if they have been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19, are experiencing a loss of taste or smell, cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat.

- If the fan answers yes, then they will be denied entry and asked to contact Indy Eleven customer service via phone or e-mail the next business day to seek a ticket exchange.

- If the fan answers no, then the health employee will perform a temperature check with a temporal thermometer. A fan who registers a temperature under 100.4 degrees will move on to the next part of entry.

- If the fan registers a temperature over 100.4 then they will be denied entry and asked to contact Indy Eleven customer service via phone or e-mail the next business day to seek a ticket exchange.

- If a fan feels their temperature reading may have been inflated because of external factors like the heat of the day or excess physical exertion they will have the option to try to "cool down" either in their vehicle or away from the gates at the perimeter of the venue before attempting entry again.

- The screenings will be provided by our partnered medical officials from Community Health Network (CHN) at all points of entry. CHN medical officials will also work closely to train and liaise with Indy Eleven Operations staff, as they did last year throughout the season with a zero-incidence rate for the entire year.

Part two of spectator entry will be the security screening.

- Wands will be utilized at each gate.

- Bags will be prohibited from entering the venue with the following exceptions:

- Bags needed for medical purposes
- Diaper bags accompanying an infant

- Small clutch or zipped wallets will be permitted inside the building (No larger than 4.5"x 6.5")

- All bags meeting the exception standards will be subject to search in a touchless manner.

- Typical supporter allowances such as tifo and instruments are prohibited, subject to prior approval.

- Individual signs of support (2 poles, flags) are still permitted.

The third and final part of spectator entry will be the ticket scan.

- Ticket scanning will be contactless. The fan will be required to display their barcode to the scanner who will scan the ticket.

- Hand sanitation stations will be placed by ingress points.

Fan Egress will be managed by security event staff.

- Sections will exit by row, with the last row exiting first and the first row exiting last.

- Fans will be encouraged to exit the stadium through the same entrance in which they entered.

- Fan egress will be monitored by stadium ushers.

- Hand sanitation stations will be placed by egress points.

- The stadium PA announcer will make multiple addresses in support of the fan egress procedures.

Press Box

- All seating in the press box will be at least 6 ft. apart.

- Buffet food and drink options for the press box will be eliminated.

- Single serve boxed meals may be made available.

Housekeeping

All housekeeping staff and efforts will have to be highly visible and follow a consistent cleaning and sanitation process through the entire duration of the event, in all the areas of the building.

- All employees will be required to wear face masks and encouraged to wash their hands with soap and water frequently/when breaks are taken.

- Hand sanitizer will be available to all employees on the field. These employees will be required to wipe down their workstations.

Housekeeping will sanitize the locker rooms with an electrostatic sprayer pregame and postgame.

Housekeeping will ensure all spectator areas are cleaned and sanitized before gates open.

Food & Beverage

All Chartwells staff will adhere to the strict guidelines put in place regarding the self-temperature screenings/temperature screening on property, wearing of face masks and gloves, increased hand washing practices as well as implementing safety shields/sneeze guards on all concession stands and food areas.

Food & Beverage Modifications - The following is a list of operational changes that Chartwells is implementing in response to COVID-19 preparedness.

- Strict adherence to physical distancing guidelines while inside venues
 - In accordance with State and Local guidance
- Implementation of hand sanitizing stations throughout venue
 - Front of House (at all service areas including points of sale, suites and catered spaces)
 - Back of House (Entrance and Exit to kitchens, pantry's and Concession Stands)
- Increased cleaning and sanitizing of frequently touched surfaces and work areas
 - Dedicated staff members to sanitize and disinfect
 - Door handles, push plates, condiment stands and food service counters
- Employee Pre-screening via wellness survey app and entrance to facilities
 - Employees with flu like symptoms are required to remain home
- Use of Personal Protective Equipment for all staff members
 - Face mask and gloves required
- Encouragement of respiratory etiquette
 - Staff trained to cover nose and mouth while sneezing or coughing
- Safety shields installed at all points of sale between staff and guests
- Modified food and beverage service
 - Adaptable menus and served in closed containers
 - Replacing bulk condiments with single-serve packets
 - Eliminating any/all refills (food or beverage)
 - Individually packaged meals
 - Increased availability of grab and go items
 - Modified catering/buffet services (back of house service areas/locker rooms)
 - Placement of hand sanitizer in all service areas and at fronts of "served" Buffet areas
- Single-use supplies
 - Covered dispensers for utensils, service ware and napkins
 - Individually wrapped cutlery
 - Use of sealed containers, wraps and lids for all food and beverage items
- Elevated COVID-19 training for team members to return to work
 - Appointment of onsite Health Ambassador focused on COVID-19 policies for ALL staff
 - Enforcement of policies throughout events within venue

Merchandise

- A limited selection of items will be available for sale at merchandise stand(s).
- Items will not be able to be tried on.
- Each stand will have a minimum of two points of sale. Each point of sale will be separated by at least 6 feet.
- Checkout lines will have floor markings indicating 6-foot intervals where customers wait.
- All employees will wear masks.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for use at each point of sale.
