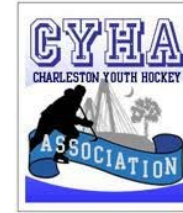
2025-2026 Season

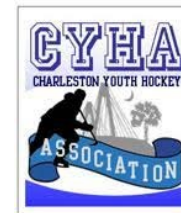

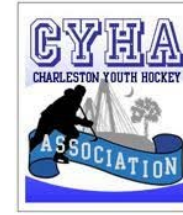

Online Voting – Simply Voting

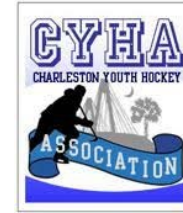


- On-line secure voting platform with full security/auditing capabilities

CYHA DIBS Policy

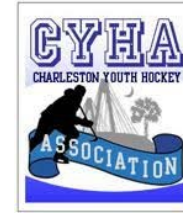
