

Real Time Migration

Migration of Legacy Data from Webpoint to USAV MMS

Migration of Data Occurs in REAL TIME

(no mass upload of data from Webpoint to USAV MMS*)

Real Time Migration is the process in which the system will match the data entered in the new system to data from Webpoint. If an exact match is found, specific pieces of data will be migrated into the USAV MMS for that member. Migrated information includes:

- Officiating certifications with expiration dates extending past the 19-20 season
- IMPACT certification
- The latest Coaching Education CAP certification
- The latest Coaching Education BCAP certification
- Background Screenings with expiration dates extending past the 19-20 season
- SafeSport credentials with expiration dates extending past the 19-20 season

*Region Holds and Suspensions will be preloaded in the system prior to launch

- Prior to launch, a profile will be created in SportsEngine for anyone who is on region hold or suspended in Webpoint and a suspension will be attached
- If a region hold, the suspension will be identified as administrative. If a suspension, the suspension will be identified as misconduct.
- An individual with a suspension will be unable to purchase a membership if they try to purchase using the same information at in their Webpoint account

How Can I Access Historical Data that will NOT be migrated into the new system?

- Webpoint available through 10/31/20
- Region can export data from Webpoint to csv files stored by a region or club
- The Region Services department will keep member, membership, club, team, credential information etc. for all seasons
- Full backup from Webpoint stored by USAV. A request can be made to obtain information that is not available in other ways

Real Time Migration occurs in both direct (member buys for themselves) and indirect (someone buys on behalf of member) flows.

The member or admin will complete purchase normally. Once purchase is submitted, the system will check historical data for a match.

- If a match is found
 - individual retains same member ID number from webpoint
 - Credentials will be migrated into member's account
 - Member will receive normal eligibility email but certain requirements have already been met (ex: wouldn't need to do BGS since current BGS migrated over from webpoint.
- If no match is found
 - Individual is given a new member ID number (starting at 4000000)
 - Member will receive eligibility email and will need to meet all requirements associated with that membership

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Keys to success for **RTM**.

Valid data is the key to success of the RTM process.

By notifying the user of their current data within the USAV legacy system, we will ensure more success in finding matches.

Proactive messaging to members

- Printing member ID card
- Email members from Webpoint where name, zip code, and DOB can be provided in email


Regions can message their members/ USAV will message this to members late August

All Members and Regions will have access to Webpoint through 10/31/2020.


What To Do When RTM Doesn't Find a Match

Realistically, we know there won't be a 100% success rate with RTM.


After membership purchase, Region Admins can manually search the Webpoint data using the legacy member ID. Once confirming its the right person, the region can manually initiate the migration of data.



Region Admin Looking at Member's Profile




Region Admin Enters 7 Digit Member ID Number

Region of Registration & Transfers

Region of Registration


- Individual's accounts are not tied to a region, memberships are tied to a region.
- Membership registration must start at a region website or a link provided by the region
- Individuals that need to become affiliated with a club must purchase a membership in the region where that club is sanctioned
- No need to change region assignment in system before individual can register with a new region

Multiple Membership Pieces


Yes- an individual can have multiple membership pieces (ex: a coach membership and an officials membership). Each membership has its own eligibility status (could be eligible as an official but not as a coach)

Yes- an individual could have multiple memberships in more than one region. These situations are being monitored and will be reported to regions. Regions can then decide the appropriate action. The system will only allow individuals to be approved as a player on one roster unless manually waivered by the region.

Region A can refund all, some

Region B has ability to discount or waive membership payment

Governing Seasons & GS Setup


Advantages of a Governing Season

Integrity of data. Memberships locked down once there is a purchase.


Keeps list of memberships etc. clean because old data is archived.

In future seasons, Regions will have the ability to copy things from season to season for ease of administration.

Season Overview




Season Detail

Region Settings - ability to track team fees

Lock Configurations - define when rosters can be locked and team details locked

Staff Title Eligibility - define which memberships are eligible for specified roles



Allows for some customization by each region.

Waivered Players

Each region can decide if they allow waivered players.

Age and gender waivers are allowed.

Grade exceptions can also be set up by a region at the division level
