

WEBER COUNTY ICE SHEET "THE ICE SHEET"

Due to demand, we are not seeking new to book ice for non-sanctioned teams or teams that float program to program. We want your teams/clubs to feel comfortable here and know that we value your business and appreciate everything you do to keep your clubs healthy. It is a group effort & it takes years to build strong clubs and we appreciate everything your Boards do to keep that up. Which brings us to the dreaded COVID procedures. These may change at any time. Please check our website for updated procedures as you approach your start dates.

- **Face coverings are currently required to enter the building, while in lobby, stands & locker rooms.** Players/Skaters do not need to wear them on the ice, however, ALL coaches do and need to make every effort to keep them on. Technically, if you are 6 feet from a player/skater, you may take them off, otherwise, they need to be on. Let's make this easy on everyone, please keep them on, only taking off briefly if they are 6 feet from a skater/player. We want everyone to feel safe. Please relay that to your coaches.
- **Temps are required to enter the facility.** All groups with contracted ice time are asked to record your own temps. We have touchless thermometers if your club volunteers would like to borrow them. Please ask at the front desk. Names and phone numbers are required to be with the temps. Please keep the recorded temps on file if the Health Department needs the info for contact tracing. To maintain HIPAA Privacy, we will not collect any info from contracted groups unless requested from the Health Department. Individuals coming in for rink-sponsored ice times will be asked their contact info upon entry.
- **As of now, each minor is allowed one adult to accompany them in the facility. We are NOT open for spectators at this time.** In the case that High School Hockey and other groups allow spectators, we will send out those requirements directly to your clubs and work with you through that process. WSU Hockey & Ogden Mustangs JR A Hockey teams will have their own, very specific, requirements for their game procedures based on Health Department requirements & their league/governing body rules. We will work with each group separately, so, if you hear different standards for different programs, that's why. Please do not rely on social media postings/discussions/here say for this info. We will work directly with your club for all COVID regulations & they will be as simple and straightforward as possible.
- **No Dryland at this time.** We will not allow team workouts/warmup/off ice classes/or use of the Pain Cave inside the facility until further notice. Your team/club/off-ice class may go outside if you must warm-up on-site.
- **Building Access/Reservations REQUIRED for the foreseeable future.** All Stick & Puck, Drop In, Freestyle, Open Skate and other rink-sponsored ice times must be reserved ahead of time. No walk-in business. Your ice times scheduled on our online schedule serve as your reservations. Please instruct your players/skaters to not show up more than **45 minutes prior to their ice booking**. We must monitor how many are in the facility and this will help us do that.
- **Individuals, coaches, players, parents should all continue to be aware of their surroundings and ask for disinfectant wipes at the front counter if they need to wipe down an area they've been in.** Locker Rooms, team benches, lobby, stands will be disinfected as needed, but based on our posted signage we are asking for all facility users to keep up on disinfecting high-touch areas they occupy. This helps us keep the facility safe for everyone.

Thank you for taking the time to read through this. I know it's a lot of info that can change rapidly. Our office will do the best we can to keep you informed and get this season off to a great start.
