The majority of our tournaments are scheduled for the year before we even have try-outs. We want to make sure that we keep on improving our home tournaments and the away tournaments and making sure that our skaters are given the opportunity for growth and development but also to have fun. Additionally, we will work with the team managers at the start of each season when teams are formed to give them flexibility if they feel that they are in a tournament that wouldn't be a good fit for their group.

Also, a reminder to those parent volunteers who are fulfilling Off-Ice Official positions ... please check the penalty box doors during the game to make sure that the doors are latched. We do not want anyone injured because a door wasn't closed properly.
