***JO UPDATE-Jason**

- Congress, refund or do the classes online
- Judges, may have to attend the online classes, live in order to receive their CPU credits, Candace will have an update for us on that after her judges meeting
- Questions regarding the USAG bankruptcy, out of USAGs hands, it's their insurance company that is making all of the bankrupt decisions
- Level 2, 3, 6 and 7 Vault, may now use a sting mat on top of all mat stacks
- 6 and 7 Vault, any arm position is acceptable after the block
- 6 and 7 Vault, one foot touch, 2 tenths deduction
- Meet directors now have the option to mix more athlete age groups
- Video Review can be done at all meets and not just the state meet, for optional levels only
- Completion of skills on beam, EX..handstand and BWO, when no feet touch the beam and there is a fall, judges can now give partial credit
- 135 degree split leap or less will be awarded an A on beam for optional levels
- 3 skill deduction on beam for optional levels, the third skill can be used in the dismount and they will receive NO up to level deduction

***Discussed meet schedule for 2020-2021 season**

- Sanctions are being given by USAG, States can make their own meet schedules using their states Covid19 guidelines, at this time in KY 50 people in a group total
- Suggestions for hosting meets, smaller sessions, allow extra time in between sessions
- There will be November and December meets in KY, Champions, Legacy, Agility, Blue Ribbon
- Derby Classic will be March 6-7, 2021
- There will be no KY Judges Cup this meet season, Excel and KGA Winter Classic will be the National Judges Cup this meet season

- Due to no state meet for the 2020 season, Excel and Legacy will have first chance at hosting state meet for 2021
- Information will go out to have KQ Meet Bids turned in by the end of July 2020
- Information will go out to have State Meet Bids turned in by the end of August 2020
- We will finalize the 2020-2021 KY Meet Schedule at the next meeting

***Championships Schedule**

- States from last year will get the first option to host, at this time all locations are TBA
- KY State Meet Levels Bronze, Silver, Gold, 2 and 3, March 20-21, 2021
- KY State Meet Levels Platinum, Diamond, 4 and Up, March 26-28, 2021
- 7 and 8 Regional April 23-25, 2021
- 9 and 10 regional April 15-18, 2021
- Gold, Platinum and Diamond Regional April 30-May 2, 2021
- Eastern May 7-9, 2021
- Nationals May 14-16, 2021
- Silver and 6 Regional May 14-16, 2021

***Judges Rankings**

- We discussed not to have sub committees for the rankings
- As a committee we can rank the judges how we see fit for our state meet
- We will lose judges this meet season due to the Corona Virus
- We set a September deadline to rank our judges for state meet
