Thank you for your interest in the Glendora Lassie League Board of Directors. Our organization functions only with the help of volunteers to manage and maintain the program for our girls.

Glendora Lassie League is a non-profit organization. It is primarily a program of service to the young ladies of our community. It is established and geared to provide an avenue for healthy activity and training under responsible leadership in the atmosphere of wholesome community participation. This League is dedicated to helping young ladies become productive citizens through wholesome fun, responsible leadership and the spirit of good sportsmanship teamwork and fair play.

Terms run from August 1 through July 31. You may be asked to be available for the June board meeting to discuss your position(s) of interest.

Board members are required but not limited to the following:

- The Board of Directors of Glendora Lassie League shall have a regularly scheduled meeting once a month, beginning in August and continuing thru July. Board members are required to attend monthly meetings. Members of the board can be removed from their positions for missing three consecutive regular board meetings.
- During the regular season, board members are required to work a minimum of two (2) board duty shifts per month.
- Board members are required to be present and help facilitate various events and functions, including but not limited to: registration, evaluation day, make-up evaluations, opening/closing ceremonies, board duty, monthly board meetings, Pride of the Foothills Tournament, and other assigned duties.

The Board of Directors accepts volunteers at the end of each season. Board members may hold office for consecutive terms, with the exception of President. In the case of multiple volunteers for a single position, selection will be determined by a vote of the current board prior to the end of its term.

Nominations will be open for at least two weeks of league play. An application must be filled out for each candidate. Each position will be selected by a majority vote of the current Board of Directors prior to July 1.
