- The Chicago Steel beat the Madison Capitols 2-0 in Game 2 of the Eastern Conference Semifinals on Monday at Fox Valley Ice Arena, pushing the best-of-three series to a deciding Game 3 on Tuesday, May 3 at Fox Valley Ice Arena ... The Steel special teams made a difference as the Chicago power play went 1-for-3 (33.3%) and the shorthanded unit posted a perfect 3-for-3 (100%) game ... Chicago trailed 26-24 in shots on goal but limited Madison to single-digit shots in the first and third periods.
- Rookie netminder **Christian Manz** earned a 26-save shutout, his first career whitewash and first career playoff victory between the Steel pipes.
- **Sam Lipkin** scored his first goal of the playoffs in the win.
- Toronto Maple Leafs prospect **Joe Miller** added a marker, his first of the Clark Cup Playoffs.
