TOURNAMENT TESTING/VACCINE RECOMMENDATIONS

The following are recommendations, but not requirements to help ensure the health and safety of all participants in the USA Hockey National Tournaments and to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 spread.

COVID-19 Testing

USA Hockey highly recommends that all participants for the 2021 National Tournament obtain a negative COVID-19 test between April 22-27, 2021, prior to traveling to the tournament host site.

Tournament Participants include:

1. Players*, coaches and team staff
2. Parents, family and spectators
3. On- and off-ice officials
4. Tournament and USA Hockey volunteer staff
5. National Office staff
6. Any other individual working in an official capacity for the national tournament

NOTE: As of April 2, 2021, players participating in Grand Rapids, Michigan, must test prior to the tournament and refer to the specific testing for that site. [Click here for details.](#)
