Pastor's Message

Saint of the Week: As a son of a princely family, **Aloysius Gonzaga** grew up in royal courts and army camps. The more Aloysius saw of court life, the more he knew this was not the life he wanted for himself. He began to learn about the lives of saints. A book about the experience of Jesuit missionaries gave him the idea of entering the Society of Jesus. After four years, he renounced his right to succession, and was received into the Jesuit novitiate.

In 1591, a plague struck Rome. The Jesuits opened a hospital of their own. Because he nursed patients, washing them and making their beds, Aloysius caught the disease. A fever persisted after his recovery and he was so weak he could scarcely rise from bed. Yet he maintained his great discipline of prayer. He died at the age of 23.
