
How to register for officiating



All Officials are required to attend a USA Hockey Officiating Seminar each season. Click Here for available seminars and be sure to check back on a regular basis as seminars will continue to be posted from July through January each season as they are scheduled in the local areas. Some of these seminars may be in person while others maybe virtual be sure to pay close attention to seminar details. You are not required to attend a seminar in your area, but you MUST attend a seminar for the level that you apply for.

All officiating requirements for the 2023-24 season need to be completed by February 28, 2024.

Be advised that some states do have child labor restrictions where there may be a minimum age requirement to officiate ice hockey. If the child registering as an Official is under the age of 14, please contact your Local Supervisor of Officials about any minimum age restrictions in your area prior to completing this registration. All officials that officiate Minnesota Hockey games are required by Minnesota Hockey bylaws to be registered members of MHOA. MHOA uses membership fees to fund development camps, subsidize Minnesota Hockey State Tournament officials' expenses, create scholarships, and evaluate/mentor officials.

For the 2023-2204 season, all officials age 17 or older will have a fee of \$12. Officials age 16 and under at the time of registration will be able to register at no cost.
