

Varsity Overview

Although the 2002-2003 Tiger Wrestling Team may not have finished exactly like we planned, (Regionals) it is now time to reflect back on what I thought was a great season. Yet again we proved to be one of the local standout teams, even with last years many departures. The 2002-2003 Varsity squad had a unique blend of youth and veterans. Varsity Captain, Darin Starkey, used his 4th letter-winning year to lead a varsity group that had between 6-8 freshmen every outing.

Despite the young team, the Tigers rattled off a 16-4 dual record, wrapping up a very respectable 2nd place finish in the strong Southwest Conference. The season started slow, by winning only 4 of our first 8 dual meets. After that start the Tigers streaked for 12 victories in a row, including wins over Roxana (State Qualifier), and Vandalia (previously unbeaten). Most of the dual meets were close and exciting, sometimes coming down to the last match. Sean Bahmani's pin vs. Roxana, and Joe Kinsey's clinching match vs. Alton come to quick memory.

I hope the Senior wrestlers, and Audra (Stat Girl), can reflect back to some of the exciting times we shared, along with the life experiences we have endured. The success that you have received has come from hard work.
