Subject: New Canada Soccer C Diploma & Ontario Soccer Grassroots Diploma Courses

Announced

As communicated via <u>Information Bulletin I2024-06</u> earlier today, Ontario Soccer is excited to announce the first available courses for both the Ontario Soccer Grassroots Diploma, a new pilot initiative, and the Canada Soccer C Diploma.

Ontario Soccer Grassroots Diploma

Overview: The Ontario Soccer Grassroots Diploma supports the coach in the grassroots and competitive environments.

Target Coach: The Grassroots Diploma is a requirement for U13 OPDL Assistant Coaches, Ontario Cup Head Coaches and IModel Pilot Project Head Coaches but is open to all coaches looking to advance their careers and understanding of the game. Please refer to each league's rules & regulations for up-to-date information on Coach Licensing Requirements.

Course Duration: 35 hours

Learning Environment:

- Two (2) days, In-person (On-field)
- Independent Online Learning (asynchronous)
- Collaborative Online Learning (synchronous)

Course Fee: \$800

Licence Validity:

Upon successful completion of the Ontario Soccer Grassroots Diploma the coach will receive a coaching licence valid for five (5) years. The licence may be maintained by following the Ontario Soccer Maintenance and Renewal Process.

Structure of the Grassroots Diploma

<u>Intensive Delivery</u>: the course will consist of four (4) in-person days which include classroom & on-field components.

Blended Delivery: the course will consist of eight (8) online sessions and two (2) on-field practical sessions.

Coaches are required to apply for the course via <u>Jotform</u>, providing proof of their completion of the prerequisites.

Canada Soccer C Diploma

Overview: The <u>C Diploma</u> develops the coach's capacity to meet the demands of coaching grassroots soccer and is the entry-course to the Advanced Coach Education Pathway.

Target Coach: The C Diploma is a requirement for OPDL and League1 Ontario Assistant Coaches but is open to all coaches looking to advance their careers and understanding of the game.

Canada Soccer C Diploma Syllabus

Course Duration: 75 hours

Learning Environment:

- 6 days, in-person (classroom & on-field)
- Independent Online Learning (asynchronous)
- Collaborative Online Learning (synchronous)
- Assessment of Competency

- NCCP Emergency Action Plan
- NCCP Understanding the Rule of Two

Course Fee: \$1,650

Licence Validity:

Upon successful completion of the C Diploma the coach will receive a coaching licence valid for three (3) years. The licence may be maintained by following the Canada Soccer Maintenance and Renewal Process.
