MBA Storm Volunteer Agreement

Hours: 20 Hours per season

5 hours per additional skater First year families – 10 hours Mites/Mini Mites – 5 hours

Each game (mini-mite through Bantams/JV) are worth 1.5 hours per game.

Varsity games are worth 2.0 hours

Charge: You will be charged \$20.00/hr for those hours not worked.

Example: total hours worked =14, Hours remaining = 6, you will be billed 6 *

\$20/hr = \$120.00

Seniors: Senior skaters/families will write a deposit check for \$400 at the beginning of the season to cover work hours. If families are short hours at the end of the season, the \$400 deposit check will be cashed and the amount due (hours short @ \$20/hour) will be kept and the remaining balance will be

returned to the family.

Penalty: You will not be allowed to register or take part in on-ice activities for the

following season until your family's account has been paid in full.

Duties that count towards your work hours:

General Maintenance *Penalty Box (game)

A. All families at each level will work tournaments at that level, regardless of hours already applied.

B. The following positions are automatically given the allotted hours if active and continued throughout the entire season: (Misc positions as needed by Board approval)

Positions qualified for 20 hours

Board Member *Concession Manager *Coach
Equipment Manager *Tournament *Scheduler

Chair Person *Advertising Manager *Fundraising Coord

Recruiter *Registration Coord

Position qualified for 10 hours

Clothing manager
*MHA Web Master

Note: hours are a total for each position (i.e. 2 members are in charge of Clothing Mngr Position, each would receive 5 hours for a combined total of 10 hours for that position)

- C. Concessions help is needed and will be scheduled throughout the season. We encouraged members to work concessions stands at either location (Benson or Morris).
- D. Please be honest with the time your are recording. The objective is to relieve the workload that it takes to complete a season and try to keep the work evenly spread across the members. This is a way for the Associations to keep costs down.
