

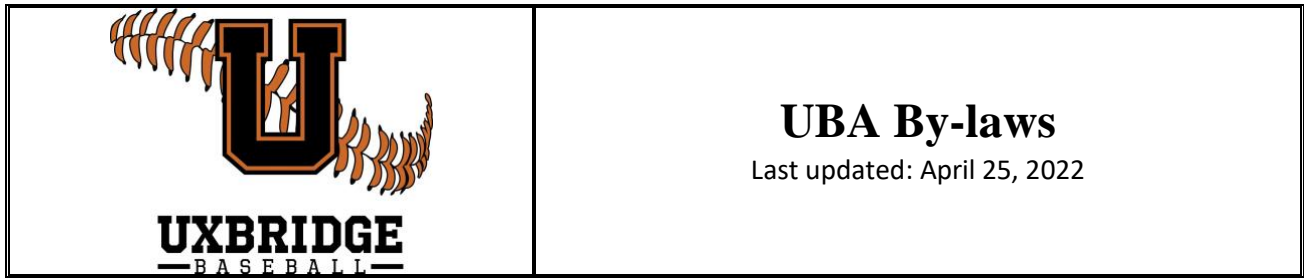


UBA By-laws

BY-LAWS OF THE UXBRIDGE BASEBALL ASSOCIATION

1. This organization is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
2. The board will govern in all matters pertaining to the Uxbridge Baseball Association.
3. The Uxbridge Baseball Association is a non-profit organization whose mission is to provide an environment for kids that promotes their enjoyment, appreciation and understanding of the game of baseball. We strive to develop the kids as both players and people in a positive, age-appropriate manner. We respect the competitive nature of baseball but will treat individual and team success and failure as a vehicle for growth and development.
4. The board will consist of 15 members. The board may exercise absolute discretion by voting in more or less than 15 members as situations arise that impact the board's ability to carry out the board's mission.
5. Members of the board will meet at the Fall General Meeting each year to vote on new members of the board. New members are not required to be present at the Fall General Meeting, but it is strongly advised that such new members be present.
6. No member may receive any financial remuneration for his or her services as a member of the board.
7. The association will not be involved in politics and no association funds will be used for any political purposes.
8. The board will meet each October to elect a Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Player Agent, and Treasurer (Executive Board "eBoard"). All of these 5 roles must be different members.
9. The Chairman will preside over each meeting, in his or her absence the Vice-Chairman will preside.
10. The board will meet each month. The Chairman will be empowered to call a meeting at any time to conduct any business relating to the association. Any 4 members of the board may petition the Chairman to call a meeting. The Chairman must then call a meeting within 2 weeks of his receipt of the petition, notifying the board members of the reason for the meeting. The first order of business at that meeting will be to address the terms of the petition.
11. Seven members of the board must be present for any meeting to be valid.
12. A simple majority of the members who voted is needed to pass any motion. Abstentions are not considered votes. The Chairman shall not vote on a motion until all other votes are cast and based on the initial results, shall then only vote if the initial votes for or against a motion are equal to break the tie. (Exception: see clause #17)

13. The board will call a meeting of all association members (managers, coaches, umpires) each Spring (~March/April), "Spring General" and Fall (~September/October), "Fall General". The board may also call a meeting for all association members when it feels it is necessary.
14. When the association members are asked to vote on any matter related to game play, and the head coach/manager of a team is not on the board, that team(s) manager shall be allowed a vote on the matter.
15. The current board members roles will be filled each year. There may be assistants assigned to each role to share the workload or to train for the future, however each position needs a single person assigned as the lead/coordinator. 16. If a member resigns, the board must appoint someone to serve out the resigning member's term.
17. Each Fall after elections of board members and assignments of the eBoard, there should be 5 members identified on 3-year terms, 5 members on 2-year terms, and the remaining board members on 1-year terms. This provides longer term commitment-based positions and some overlap from year-to-year of some board members to then elect new members for the upcoming season.
18. If any board member misses 3 consecutive regular monthly meetings without notifying the Executive Board, that board member will be automatically removed from the UBA Board.



19. The Treasurer will submit an annual financial report to the board members at the regular monthly meeting in October.

20. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this unincorporated association, the debts and obligations of the association will be paid by the Treasurer. The remaining assets shall be distributed with the Board's approval to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation, based within the Town of Uxbridge, which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

21. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the unincorporated association shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or (b) by an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

22. These By-Laws may be amended only at a meeting of all association members present at that meeting. Any amendment must carry a 2/3 majority using the voting procedure previously described.
