    - Only students in grades 9-11 may participate

- Teams may roster 5 Junior year players but not dress more than three (3) for a game.
  - JV players may only play 4 games at varsity and on the 5th, they are not allowed to return to JV
    - This includes any combination of 5 total games between WNY Club varsity, federation varsity or prep
- Dates to remember

    - Note for the 2019-2020 season that the 4th number will be a “0”. Last years number will have a “9”.
  - **Due October 15-** All coaching requirements need to be fulfilled.
    - Remember that coaches are NOT allowed to participate in tryouts or practices until APPROVED by USA hockey and on the teams’ official roster. This means safesport, screening, modules and CEP is up to date.
  - **November 11-** Tryouts may begin
  - Post Tryouts- Send Nate Streicher the NFJV roster template complete with players names, positions, numbers and USA hockey confirmation numbers.
  - **Due December 15-** League fees
  - **December 31-** Rosters are frozen for the season. All CEP requirements are due.
