



2021 Grades 3-6 House League Season Summary

Season Information

- Season will start February 1st and will run for six (6) weeks.
- Games will be held on five (5) consecutive Saturdays, beginning February 13th.
- Registration will open January 8 and will close on January 22. No late registrants will be allowed, no exceptions.
- Coaches and Teams will be decided the week of January 25th.
- Fee will be \$85 per athlete (this includes a jersey). Partial refunds will be given if we are unable to complete 50% of the season. Refunds will be reviewed by the Board as necessary
- 3-6 House League is for athletes within the ISD 318 school boundary only

Safety Requirements

- Every athlete, coach, official and event staff will be required to perform daily self-evaluations before participating.
- Masks/face coverings must be worn at all times unless a medical condition prohibits the use. A medical waiver will need to be provided from a medical professional prior to participating.
- During games and practices, masks/face coverings are **required** for youth athletes, coaches and officials, **at all times**.
- Should state executive orders lessen the restrictions on masks/face coverings during organized sports, we will communicate those updates
- Physical distancing is expected and encouraged whenever possible
- It is a requirement that a parent/guardian report any positive case or close contact exposure (for their child who is a player) to GRABA's Covid Compliance Manager
- Athletes must provide their own mask/face covering and water bottle

Facility Access

- Practices may only be attended by team members and coaches.
- Limited attendance will be allowed during games based on the current requirements of the Executive Order and ISD 318.
- Parents will not be able to enter the facility when dropping off / picking up their athlete

- Athletes are not allowed to arrive early or loiter in other spaces. Participants must enter through the main doors, go directly to the gym, and exit immediately after practice.
- Practice and games will be scheduled with “transition” times to minimize contact.

Rosters and Games

- Rosters will be determined based on registration numbers. It is planned to divide teams into 5th/6th grade levels and 3rd/4th grade levels, but the Board reserves the right to adjust teams.
- Teams may be adjusted during the season based on participation and competition level
- Requests for a player or players to be placed on specific teams will not be granted. No exceptions.
- GRABA is planning to “Live Stream” games if possible. Parents/Guardians must opt-out if they do not want their athlete to be shown on media platforms

Players and Coaches

- All athletes will have equal playing time during games. Coaches will do their best to equitably share time
- Players and coaches should show proper sportsmanship at all times.
- The intent of the in-house leagues is to provide an opportunity to play for all athletes, not necessarily win games
- The opportunity to coach is a privilege granted by the Board. Any negative conduct by a coach towards players, opponents or referees during practices and/or games will not be tolerated and may result in removal as coach.
