

Opening Letter Revised 6/18/20

The following email was sent to all members on behalf of Heather (club manager and the SS&T Board on 6/18/20.

There was a lot that needed to fall into place in order to open this weekend and we are overjoyed to say that due to the incredible dedication of Heather, our guards and our amazing volunteers, that we have passed our Board of Health inspection and we are green lit to **open on Saturday!**

Throughout the summer season, please continue checking emails, our [website](#), or our [Facebook page](#) for updates. All 3 are actively used for club communication.

Please take the time to read the [Club Operating Plan](#) from start to finish before coming to the club.

We are opening under MA state COVID 19 requirements that we are required to follow. A few key points are highlighted below (detailed descriptions are available via the Club Operating Plan).

1. Current Massachusetts State Social Distancing Guidelines are 6 feet between non-family members if you are not wearing a mask.
 - Please stay 6 ft apart when entering the club.
 - When swimming in the pool, you are not required to wear a mask, but you are required to maintain the 6 ft guidelines.
 - Members are primarily responsible to ensure they & their family members observe social distancing rules
 - Lifeguards will not be monitoring social distance spacing outside of the pool as they will be focused on keeping swimmers safe.
 - We respect each other and we ask that all members act responsibly in regard to the state's social distancing guidelines.
2. It may seem obvious – DO NOT COME to the club if you are sick or are exhibiting any of the COVID-19 symptoms!
3. The pool deck is being configured to better enable social distancing.
 - Fewer chairs/lounges
 - Leverage the lawn area for additional social distancing
 - You are welcome to bring your own chairs and exercise appropriate distancing

1. Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the club and we require that you sanitize your hands before and after using the pool and the tennis courts.
 - Members are encouraged to bring their own sanitization supplies as well.
2. Bathrooms will be open with social distancing rules in place with one-way entrance and exit. Bathrooms are indoors and we respectfully request that adults wear masks and supervise their younger children in the bathroom.
3. Please note, changing rooms will be closed until Phase 3 (~ 6/29).
4. The following policies are in place and will be reevaluated as the summer progresses
 - No guests are allowed at this time.
 - Lost and found is on hold – Please take care of belongings (towels, goggles, clothing, etc)

A note regarding registration for swim and tennis programs will follow this message.
