Game Balls and Warm Up Balls Provided

START: Doors open 8:00 am. Coaches' meeting at 8:10am on Court 1. The first match will start promptly at 8:30 am for Pools 1 & 2 and at 9:00am for Pool 3. Pool play and tournament brackets will be on a ROLLING SCHEDULE.

ADMISSIONS: \$5 for adults.

POOL PLAY: Pool 1 & 2 – 2 sets to 25, cap at 27. Pool 3 – 3 sets to 25, cap at 27. This will give each team the same number of sets & points for seeding in the tournament.

WARM-UP FORMAT: 4-4-2 for each team's first match. 2 minutes shared, at ref's discretion after that. Coin flip to determine who has the net first.

OFFICIATING: A coach must be R1 or R2 for each match (bring your own whistle). Officiating team must also provide 1 scorekeeper and 2 line judges. Refer to schedule for pool play. Referee schedule can be found on the bracket located just outside the gym. The team assigned to referee is responsible for starting all matches on time.

PLAYOFFS: 1st and 2nd place teams in each pool go to the Gold Division. Ranking based on pool play set win/loss record. Tie breaker is head-to-head, point differential, coin flip. 3rd and 4th place teams in each pool go to the Silver Division. Championship t-shirt awarded to 1st Place teams in Gold Division. Warm up will only be allotted for first tournament match 2-2-1. Shared 2 minutes for every match after. If both coaches agree, the warmup can be forfeited. Best 2 out of 3 sets. 3rd set to 15. No caps, must win by 2 pts.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available on site. Please NO coolers.

Points for Pudwill

Bring some quarters and please help us in supporting this CVC family! Rylie has been an athlete with CVC for the past 2 years.

Background: "Melanie was diagnosed with VHL (Von Hippel-Lindau) disease while she was pregnant with her first daughter, Rylie. VHL is a rare, inherited disease that causes tumors to grow in the body. These tumors typically grow in the brain, spinal cord, kidneys, pancreas, adrenal glands and reproductive tract. Unfortunately, Melanie has had numerous tumors grow in her brain. She had her first brain surgery right after the birth of her daughter, Rylie. For the past 14 years, Melanie has undergone numerous scans and procedures to monitor and remove these tumors. This past year has been financially difficult for the Pudwill family with numerous trips and procedures done at Mayo. Earlier last year, Melanie had a gamma knife procedure to try to remove the tumors without opening her head for brain surgery. The procedure was effective for the smaller tumors, but unfortunately, the larger tumors reacted, resulting in her having emergency brain surgery in October at Mayo. Her out of pocket costs not covered by insurance are very high since her procedures have had to be done at Mayo. Melanie will have to make continued trips to Mayo to monitor and treat the tumors that were unable to be removed due to their size and location in her brain. Please consider donating to the Pudwill family to help with their accumulating medical expenses."
