

## Illness and Exclusion Policy

<i>Children must <u>stay at home</u> if they have any of the following symptoms/illnesses:</i>	<i>Readmission Criteria</i>
<i>Ear or Oral temperature of 101 or higher</i>	<i>24 hrs fever free without medication</i>
<i>Underarm temperature of 100 or higher</i>	<i>24 hrs fever free without medication</i>
<i>Conjunctivitis (Pink Eye)- redness of the eye or lids, usually with secretion of yellowish discharge and crusting</i>	<i>Effective treatment and approval/note from a Doctor</i>
<i>A Rash you cannot identify that has not been diagnosed</i>	<i>Effective treatment and approval/note from a Doctor</i>
<i>Diarrhea- two or more times within the past 24 hours</i>	<i>12 hrs symptom free</i>
<i>Vomiting within 24 hours</i>	<i>24 hrs symptom free</i>
<i>Any contagious disease including Measles, Chicken Pox, Mumps, Roseola, Impetigo, and Strep Throat.</i>	<i>Approval / Note from a Doctor</i>
<i>Head lice</i>	<i>After treatment with medicated shampoo/lotion. No nits present</i>
<i>Influenza</i>	<i>After fever subsides</i>
<i>Any illness that prevents the child from participating in the program comfortably.</i>	<i>Child is ready to participate in all indoor and outdoor activities</i>

To return to the center after an illness, please bring a note from your physician indicating that the child is ready to resume participation in all activities.

Children's exclusion and readmission to the center is subject to review by WAYA Preschool Director or Assistant Director.

If your child has a chronic illness or disability please discuss this with the director so that reasonable accommodations may be made.
