Committee Report 11 Risk Management

Baseball BC did send out general reminder to all organizations and members April 30th. Essentially no changes at this time in Return to Play (RTP) with reminders of what is and is not allowed under Phase 2 Stage 1.

HOLDOVER FROM PREVIOUS REPORTS - Reminder

We continue to receive many questions from associations as registrations are opening for 2021 with risk management concerns. I am really concerned based on the amount of questions about ViaSport and Baseball BC Return to Play RTP guideline phases that are not being communicated effectively downward to coaches and members.

Friendly reminder, we are all still under ViaSport/Baseball BC Return to Play (RTP) Phase 2 Step 1 guidelines and safety protocols as of this date. Last update from Baseball BC was March 1^{st} . RTP is now extending to players over the age of 22 in limited to small group team training/development (maximum size of 10 persons).

Baseball BC did update adult and player waivers and declarations which can be now found on the BCMBA website under "More/Resources/COVID-19 Resources" and also distribution online. Adult and player waivers and declarations from 2020 are still valid.

We do not know what this year will look like yet, but in my many, many conversations so far please plan for another "not-so-traditional year" of programming. We will message and help all associations and keep lines of communication open. We have no idea at this time when/if game play may start in the province. It is practice only at this time and BCMBA will advise when next steps can be taken in returning to game play.

As of this date:

- **No** games (no team simulated/inter-squad game scenarios ex: batter, pitcher, runners & fielders at the same time)
- No Interlocks/cohorts
- No travel.

Associations please be prepared to "instruct/train" coaches/volunteers that were not part of any RTP in 2020 as all protocols and guidelines are still in place. It is not at this time a return to traditional play or training. Any questions please do not hesitate BCMBA to ask as there are a number of member associations that did not have any programming in 2020 and have not done any preparation or posting of protocols on their respective website.

Marketing Committee Report

- The Chair continues to study content creation and media editing in order to up our quality and effectiveness of our digital marketing campaigns (online training) and has built some training content to date
- Continued resource planning to promote the naturally RTP compliant nature of baseball and the preparedness
 of our member associations to provide healthy and compliant outdoor recreation for BC youth
- The BCMBA Marketing Committee met on April 14th. Among the items discussed were;
 - Coaches Conference 2021 Review
 - Coaches Conference marketing for the future
 - Discussed and identified the three key pillars of the committee's role in support of the growth and development of youth baseball in our member communities. Those pillars are defined as membership benefits promotion, revenue generation, and information distribtuion
 - It is the intent of the Marketing committee to collaborate with BCMBA program and event committees to grow and improve the value of BCMBA programming for our members. This could be as simple as liaising with updates or as cooperative as a joint event task force
 - This should allow the committee to be more nimble and progress quicker when working on initiatives as it won't necessarily require the entire committee to be hands on at all times
 - The Marketing committee will work to establish an annual marketing plan that includes timelines with benchmarks
 - The Marketing committee has identified five initiatives as a focus and foundation of our actions;
 - 2022 BCMBA Coaches Conference (Worldwide)
 - BCMBA sponsored prize promotions via BCMBA SM channels to define and demonstrate our SM marketing platforms
 - Mother's Day Celebration campaign
 - BCMBA Member branding tools and resources
 - Creation of surveys to identify areas of need based on the perspectives of our member associations
- The Marketing committee will work with the Coach Development, High Performance, and event committees to create a collaborative and efficient process of supporting those programs
- The Marketing committee will continue to meet on a monthly basis to build our effectiveness
