


About the NABA...

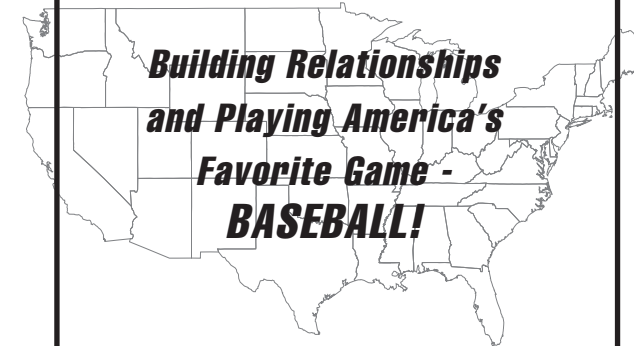

NABA Participant Contract

FOR YOUR PEACE OF MIND...

Each participant in the NABA must complete a Participant Contract to be able to compete in the NABA. These contracts set forth very specific guidelines for the participation of each individual.

The NABA believes it is important to point out some of the more pertinent parts of the contract. If you wish to review a complete contract, please feel free to ask the local league president for a copy, or call the National Office, and a copy will be sent to you promptly.

What you need to know about the NABA Participant Contract:

- The participant agrees not to possess or consume any alcoholic beverages or drugs at any time on the playing field, in the dugouts, bleachers, or other areas near or around the playing field facility...
- The participant agrees not to participate in fighting, physical abuse of players, umpires, or spectators
- The participant agrees to abide by local facility rules and regulations
- The participant understands that the NABA, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to refuse any player or team permission to play in any NABA league
- The participant agrees to and understands that violation of any part of the contract may result in... forfeiture of games, suspension from play, fines, or permanent expulsion from the NABA
- The participant...understands that they have total responsibility for any personal injury, accident, illness...while participating in any NABA function...
- Additionally, a waiver of liability is part of each contract and is signed by each participant

Insurance Coverage

The NABA carries a \$2,000,000 liability insurance policy covering general liability and umbrella / excess liability insurance which will cover your organization and their employees for liability arising from any use of a facility or participation in any sporting activity. A copy of the insurance policy naming your facility (school, park district, etc.) will be provided for your records.

The relevant policy terms are as follows:
