# **Registration steps for HLYH:**



# **Enter USA Hockey Confirmation # to begin registration:**



Please note: All 1<sup>st</sup> year players are required to submit a certified birth certificate for verification to be rostered on a team.

Once all the required information is entered, you then choose one of the teams below:

- Tyke/Mite \$100
- Squirt through HS \$140
- Adult Leagues \$120
- College Student \$25
- Family Max for registration and volunteer check \$400
- Discount of \$5/family member on a team

These fees are in addition to USA Hockey registration AND volunteer checks. (Either \$200 or \$400, depending on your registration. Example: 1 Mite and/or Adult player plus 1 Squirt player = \$400)



HLYH provides equipment (excluding helmet) FREE to 1st year players and equipment rental is available if needed.

Overall registration for a player is broken down **roughly** estimated to:

\$60 – USA Hockey - Depends on level of player

\$140 – Player fee – **Depends on level of player** 

\$400 – Volunteer Check (Not cashed if all volunteer hours are met)

= \$600 (In addition to possible jersey fees, purchase of personal equipment and travel expenses)

NEW: As of August 1, 2024, USA Hockey REQUIRES players in all age classifications, except adults, to wear neck guards, for all games and practices.

### Important Information:

Volunteer checks (postdated to April 1<sup>st</sup> of the following year) MUST be given to OR mailed to Heather Dulaney @ 20 Robertson Ct, Glasgow, MT 59230. The amount is \$200.00 for Tyke/Mite & Adult Players. Volunteer checks for teams of Squirt level and up are \$400. HLYH members and families are encouraged to complete 40 volunteer points for Squirt level and up. Tyke/Mite & Adult Players are encouraged to complete 20 volunteer points. Should you meet the required volunteer hours HLYH will return your volunteer check at the end of the season. \*You may donate up to 10 total hours to another family. However, families that were awarded a scholarship cannot receive donated hours.\*

Volunteer opportunities include but are not limited to team caller, concessions, rink prep & take down, penalty box, scoreboard operator, Zamboni drivers, skate sharpening, rink cleaning, etc. New parents are encouraged to get hours by working concessions.

Dibs is available on our HLYH website to sign up for volunteer shifts and it keeps track of each player's accrued hours. Volunteer hours are also available during the off-season. Please contact a board member with any questions.

\*\*\*Rink cleaning is required of each player and their families. Each team is assigned a week alternating throughout the season. Ice time is earned by helping keep our facility clean. Please do your part.\*\*\*

If a jersey is needed, make sure to get it turned into Christina Hunter, right away. Payment is required at the time of order and is no longer processed online. They are \$60 each for Tyke/Mite level through Bantam. A limited number are available to borrow from the rink if unable to purchase at the time of registration.

- Tyke/Mite level is not required to purchase any however, can if desired.
- Squirt level is only required to purchase a black jersey.
- PeeWee, Bantam, 14U do need to have both a black and white jersey.
- HS Boys and 19U are roughly \$110 for both jerseys.
  - According to USA Hockey, it is mandatory that any high school player turning 18 DURING the season year is required to take Safe Sport, NO exceptions. The player will not be a certified, rostered player and will be unable to practice or compete until it is completed.
- \*\*Scholarships are available to all players by contacting the registrar or a board member. All volunteer hours need to be met, and no additional donated hours can be received if a scholarship is awarded.\*\*
