

BASEBALL PEI POLICY

Association in Good-Standing with Baseball PEI

1.1 Criteria

- These are the following criteria for a member Association of Baseball PEI to be afforded the rights and privileges Baseball PEI bestows on Associations who are in good standing with Baseball PEI:
 - The Association has a Constitution that has been legally approved/adopted at an advertised public meeting.
 - The Association has a clearly defined geographical area that is being programmed by the proposed Association.
 - The Association must have a duly elected governance body, with a Board of Directors and/or an Executive.
 - The Association must hold at least one public meeting a year and/or hold an Annual General Meeting open to the public prior to 30 April of the calendar year, and provide the minutes of that Annual General Meeting to Baseball PEI.
 - The Association must meet all of the registration and fee requirements of Baseball PEI.
