

## **Overview:**

## **Pee Wee Cheer | Grades 1<sup>st</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> | Registration Fee \$95**

Pee Wee Cheer focuses on learning the fundamentals of cheerleading including basic motions, jumps, cheers and chants with emphasis on team building, sportsmanship, and dedication to be a part of a team.

- 8wk cheer season

## **Sanger Youth Sports Cheer FAQ**

What does it cost to cheer?

- For Mini Cheer, there is a registration fee of \$40 and a uniform package fee of \$80.
- For Pee Wee Cheer, there is a registration fee of \$95 and a uniform package fee of \$240.

When does the season begin?

- Practices begin the first week of August. Cheer practices at least two days a week. Actual days, times and location are determined by the coach.

Where are practices?

- Practices are held at Porter Park in the open area near the pavilion or at Indium Stadium located at Sanger High School. Specific location, practice days and times will be announced by your coach after the close of registration.

How often do teams practice?

- Practices are held at least 2 nights per week throughout the season. Specific practice location, practice days and times will be announced by your coach after the close of registration.

How many games will we cheer?

Each squad will cheer for approximately 6-8 games. This may extend if your football team makes the playoffs and/or Super Bowl game.

Where are games played?

- Home games are played at Indian Stadium. We also travel to surrounding communities for away games. For directions to other field sites, please refer to the SYS Football facilities page.

Is there an entry fee to watch games?

- All regular season games typically charge \$3-\$5 per person. All money collected goes to offset the field operating cost. Cheerleaders do not pay these entry fees.

How will I know if practice/games are cancelled due to rain?

- Any practices/games cancelled due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances will be sent out using the team management tool utilized by your squad. All cancellations will also be posted to the SYS Cheer Facebook page.

How can I get involved with SYS Cheer?
