Event Details

- **Dates:** October 17–19
- **Location:** National Sports Center – Blaine, MN Campus
- **Fields:** Games will be played on premium turf fields (29, #30, and #31)
- **Teams:** 3rd–8th grade youth community-based tackle football teams representing MN and WI.

The Blaine Youth Football Classic operates under a **Youth 1st Environment**, promoting a safe, fun atmosphere that prioritizes sportsmanship and respect from coaches, players, and spectators alike.

Important Reminders

Mandatory Coaches Meeting

To ensure all coaches and team representatives are fully aligned, a **mandatory virtual coaches meeting** will be held: **Thursday, October 16 at 6:30 PM** Please watch your inbox for a separate email containing the meeting link and access details.

Roster Submission

Each team must complete and submit the **official Blaine Youth Football Classic Roster** (available in your *RegisterPlay* team portal).

Rosters will be verified at **team check-in**, at least **30 minutes prior to your first scheduled game** on Friday.

Team Check-In

A head coach or adult team representative (team manager) **must check in at Tournament Headquarters** 30 minutes prior to your first game. Teams will not be allowed to play until check-in is complete.

- **Proof of Age/Grade Documentation:** Teams must have player age/grade verification available upon request. It is each team's responsibility to provide the necessary documentation to the Tournament Protest Committee if a player's age or grade is formally challenged by an opposing team.

Tournament Headquarters Location/Directions

National Sports Center – Fields 29-32 Entrance

- All participants and spectators should **enter Lot A from Davenport St. NE**
- Once inside Lot A, drive straight ahead and follow event signage directing you to **Fields 25–32 and Lot C.**
- **Additional parking will be available in Lot A and Lot D.**
- **Right-turn only when exiting** onto Davenport St. NE to help traffic flow smoothly.
- Please review the **event map** in advance for reference.

Admissions

Admissions will be collected at the **main tournament entrance (entrance to fields off of Parking Lot C).**

- Players and Coaches listed on the official roster will receive wristbands during team check-in.
- Spectators must have a valid admission wristband to enter the turf area.
Wristbands will be color-coded to distinguish between daily and weekend passes.

Admission Rates:

- **Daily Pass:** \$10 per adult | \$5 per student (ages 7–18), senior citizen, or veteran | Children 6 & under: Free
 - **Weekend Pass:** \$20 per adult | \$12 per student, senior citizen, or veteran
- ⇒ **Bring chairs**
