- Leggings should only be worn if shirt comes to the thigh
- I will show respect for the coaches. I understand that there are concerns which may be appropriate to discuss with the coaches such as: ways to help your child improve, concerns about your child's behavior, or the mental or physical treatment of your child. I also understand there are issues that are not appropriate to discuss with the coaches such as: team strategy, play calling, or other student athletes. I understand that my student is encouraged to respectfully discuss concerns directly with a coach (for example: tips for improving or playing time).
- If I have a Huskies-related concern regarding the Huskies program, a coach, or other persons within the Huskies family, I will first go to that person in a loving and respectful manner to seek understanding and resolution of the concern. ## Waiver (page 1 of 2)

Participation in high school athletics has many rewards, and we hope that all parents and players involved with the **HUSKIES** this year experience many of these rewards and know how much we appreciate your involvement. It is important that parents and players understand the element of physical risk involved with competitive athletics. The purpose of this letter is to be clear on our position in terms of insurance coverage for an injured player and to obtain parental permission to secure medical assistance should an athlete be injured.

As we are in cooperation with Bethany International, Southview Christian School, and Bethlehem Baptist Church with respect to our gym facilities, it is important that you know that the **SOUTH METRO HUSKIES** do carry accident and liability insurance for our players in case of personal injury as a result of athletic participation. It may be important that you check with your own insurance carrier to see how this affects your own insurance situation.

Most injuries suffered by basketball athletes are of the nature of sprains, cuts, and bruises. We assure you that we have no intention of overreacting to minor injuries; however, we must reserve the right to seek specialized emergency treatment in the case that a parent is not physically present and the injury is severe enough to require immediate treatment in the judgment of **HUSKIES**' coaches and officials.

Further, it is obvious that in the case of ridesharing and carpooling to games and practices, drivers – students or adults – are responsible for their own insurance, and that driver, riders, and parents understand that neither Bethany International, Southview Christian School, Bethlehem Baptist Church, nor the **HUSKIES**, or any other school or facility can assume responsibility for injuries suffered in an automobile-related incident.
