Coach Pryor provided update on all CSHS teams currently in regular seasons or playoffs. All of CSHS will be closed this summer, so Elite Camp will take place completely in Field House; SSI may be at alternate locations. Construction update for stadium provided. All projects should be complete by beginning of school in August.

Discussion about future use of funds to purchase larger ticket items for existing and new locker rooms, weight rooms when construction is complete; construction updates to concession stands. Consider putting money into an account where scholarships could come from interest on that account. Chuck is going to ask to speak to all of the coaches before next year to encourage them to submit more funding requests.

New Business: Consideration/Discussion/Possible Action

1. Scoreboard Advertising - hold for next meeting
2. Digital Fan Guide - discussion had about whether or not digital fan guide is still necessary with new scoreboard advertising, website marketing. Will consider have QR code with links to team rosters.
3. Website Update - Patrick working on new website. Need to find out if we can keep URL or decide on a new one.
4. Memberships vs. Sponsorships - Chuck proposed setting up a working group to look at processes for memberships and sponsorships in the future. Suggested that we have fewer membership types, all advertising will go through sponsorship process. Chuck, Elaine, Scott, Will, TJ will meet to discuss and bring suggestions back to a future meeting.
5. Discussion on increasing debit card daily limit from \$2,500 to \$10,000. Chuck and Haley will approach the bank about how to do this. Board members present were in favor of allowing increase.
