## Jan Hallgrimson Presentation

Janet Hallgrimson attended meeting as a guest with some information she wanted to share and discuss for our Female program going forward:

- Recently had some parents/friends approach her with questions about Females only
- Reminded us to be cautious to start female hockey programs at the U7/U9 levels
- That can hurt the players' hockey development and enrollment
- Belief that there is great benefit with boys and girls playing together at a young age when sex (size) differences do not yet impact the sport
- Aware that varying experiences and abilities can be a deterrent to some players from starting or staying with hockey when they start late and have less experience with hockey.
- 1 day a week open female hockey could offset that
- It would allow new girls to build up their abilities and social confidence to stay in sport
- Also would allow to close the gap skill wise for when playing/trying out Co-Ed
- Understanding that cost can affect both boys/girls hockey and would like to see once a week maybe a stick and puck hour (kids rec hockey) for kids/families that can't afford to play
- Janet is wanting to organize shinny/shmockey nights on the outdoor rink weekly too
- Overall happy with TPMH and our current practice. Just a reminder not to push for girls only at too early of a level and continue on with as much Co-Ed to try to keep everyone in hockey
