



Our Mission Statement: ...to develop skating talent and team skills for local, regional, national, and international competition. We will foster sportsmanship, the development of life skills and aim to achieve the highest level of athletic performance balanced with high standards of moral conduct both on and off the ice.

Synchronized figure skating involves teams of 8 to 20 athletes simultaneously performing challenging formations and intricate step sequences on the ice. Programs are choreographed and performed with grace, intensity, athletic skill, and passion. Formed in 1956, the sport was previously known as "precision skating" for the synchronized moves that skaters would perform. The first World Championships were held in the year 2000, and today there are over 600 registered synchronized skating teams in the United States alone and several hundred more in countries all over the world. The sport is growing exponentially with competitions routinely streamed on apps such as Peacock ©.

Starlights is the largest and most comprehensive synchronized skating club in the Midwest with teams competing in 10 different divisions from Snowplow Sam through Open Masters. Depending on the level, our teams compete in regional, national and international competitions. Our Junior Team has a long history of representing the United States at international competitions. These competitions have taken them to Austria, Croatia, France, Italy, Sweden, and Switzerland. Aside from bringing home medals, these invaluable experiences have given our skaters life skills and a widened perspective of the world that will last a lifetime.

In addition to the hard work and immense dedication from our skaters, their coaches, and their parents, the support we have received from our sponsors have also been an indispensable part of our success. This sport is extremely costly, with annual dues running in the thousands of dollars per skater per season. At Starlights, we strive to provide these opportunities to as many skaters in our community by trying to keep these dues as reasonable as possible.
