



2025 MEN'S RECREATIONAL LEAGUE PLAYING RULES

1. The first **15 player registration forms** are to be submitted by **May 1st, 2025**. Players must register on the KNSC PowerUp portal.
2. All players MUST register with the Kleinburg Nobleton Soccer Club Power Up portal at least 2 business days before the team's before they are approved to play.
3. Players names hand written on game sheets will not qualify to play until they are properly registered.
4. All player photos (required for the game sheets) must be emailed to admin@knscc.ca at least one week prior to the first game. If a player photo is not submitted that player is deemed ineligible to play.
 - a. Original photo ID must be provided at every game before kick-off to be eligible to play
 - b. Cell phone photos will not be accepted by the Referee
5. The League will allow a maximum of 22 players on the roster. All 22 players may be dressed and present on the bench.
 - a. Extra players may register, but the maximum allowed on all rosters remains a maximum of 22.
 - b. Roster adjustments (addition/removal of players) requires 1 week (5 business days) prior to kick off and player registration fees must be processed
 - c. Hand written players names in game sheets are not acceptable at any time.
 - d. Players names showing NO WAIVER in game sheets, are not allow to play at any time.
6. Last day to register players on the team roster will be Thursday July 31st 2025.
7. There will be 2 separate divisions: **Division A and Division B** *subject to viable teams registered for each division
8. Games will be scheduled on Sundays;
 - a. No games will be played on long weekends.
 - b. Rescheduled games will be played on Fridays 7 p.m. and 9 p.m.
 - c. Teams will be given 7 days notice of rescheduled games

9. Game times will be commencing at **3 PM onwards**
 - a. Unlit fields may commence earlier due to shortened daylight times (August)
10. No team will be allowed to play their first game until all league fees are paid in FULL.
11. Game sheets with player names and jersey numbers will be handed out weekly by the Field Convenor 20 minutes prior to kick off. Captain must confirm game sheet prior to the start of game.
12. Teams must have numbers on all player jerseys and properly added on game sheets.
 - a. League will allow 2 games grace if teams are waiting for jerseys.
 - b. NO taped on numbers will be allowed
 - c. Teams utilizing previous year's uniforms and adding players, all jerseys must be the same colour and must not duplicate player numbers
13. This League will run on a Points system: Win= 3 points, Tie= 1 point, Loss= 0 points
14. Any protests must be filed with the club accompanied by fee (\$100) payment during or immediately following the conclusion of the game.
15. Any team that forfeits a game will be recorded as a 3-0 loss, and a \$75.00 fine will be imposed. The fine must be paid prior to the next scheduled game.
16. Games that are cancelled due to field closures by the City of Vaughan will be re-scheduled by the League.
 - a. All rescheduled games will be hosted on Friday evenings and/or Sunday mornings
17. In the event a game has to be stopped for any reason, as long as at least 50% (45 minutes) of the game has been completed, this will be deemed a completed game.
 - a. 50% of originally scheduled kick off time
18. *In the event of severe weather (ie: continuous heavy rain, lightning, excessive heat), the League has the authority to change the duration of games or any other functions of the League which includes such things as the following:
 - a. Relocate and/or reschedule any games.
 - b. Reduce, by up to 30 per cent, the scheduled duration of any Game including playoffs.
 - c. Cancel any game in the preliminary round that has no bearing in deciding who advances through to the Play-offs.
 - d. A game is considered complete when 50% has been played and/or if a Referee abandons a game due to a fight or suspends game due to Team(s) failing to field 7 players on the pitch (with a 15-minute grace period.)

19. FIGHTING OR SPECTATOR INTERFERENCE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED - THE LEAGUE HAS THE RIGHT TO SUSPEND AND TERMINATE THE PLAYER(S) OR TEAMS FROM PLAYING IN THE LEAGUE.

20. Fines must be paid in full prior to a team's next game. Failure to do so will result in the team forfeiting all subsequent games until such time as fines are paid.

- a. Payments may be made at the Clubhouse during regular business hours

21. Play-offs will be scheduled according to the number of teams registered.

22. League Champions - If teams are tied at the conclusion of the Regular Season, winners in each Division will be decided as follows: 1) Head to Head; 2) Win vs. Loss and total team Goals for and against.

23. At the end of the season the following prizes and trophies will be distributed:

- a. League winners will receive Prize Money and League Trophy
- b. Playoff winners will receive Play-off Trophy

PENALIZED PLAYERS:

- Red cards: minimum 1 game suspension, additional suspension will be based on KNSC Disciplinary Board Review.
- If a player is cautioned with 2 yellow cards in the same game it will result in an automatic 1 game suspension
- If a player accumulates 5 yellow cards in a season automatic 1 game suspension, additional suspension will be based on KNSC Disciplinary Board Review
