



MN Special Hockey Player Code of Conduct

Minnesota Special Hockey's (MSH) goal is for each player to increase personal development and self-confidence on and off the ice by learning teamwork, increased physical activity, gain friendships and, most importantly, have fun.

This Player Code of Conduct applies to all MSH players. A MSH player is defined as someone currently registered as a participant on a Minnesota Wild Special Hockey team.

Players' Code of Conduct

- ☐ I will respect all players, coaches, families, and fans.
- ☐ I will respect all property and equipment at MSH events at my home arena or at another facility.
- ☐ I will demonstrate a positive team orientated attitude.
- ☐ I will always do my best at both practices and games.
- ☐ I will help my fellow teammates and other players succeed.
- ☐ I will come to all practices and games dressed and ready to play.
- ☐ I will be on time for all practices and games.
- ☐ I will attend a minimum of 60% of all practices and games
- ☐ I will only score up to three (3) goals per game. After scoring three (3) goals I will:
 - Assist other players in the game.
 - Pass the puck to other players.
 - Help other players score.
 - Help keep the game moving.
- ☐ I will share ice time equally with my teammates.
- ☐ I will be a role model for other players to follow.
- ☐ I will help my fellow players have fun!
- ☐ I will not check or fight.
- ☐ I will not use profanity at MSH events on or off the ice.
- ☐ I will be a Team Player. When a team wins, we all win!!!

In the event a Player does not follow the Player Code of Conduct the coach may enforce one or more of the consequences identified below:

- Player must attend a meeting with their coach and possibly a parent / guardian.
- Player will not be allowed to “touch” the puck during a practice or game.
- Player may only pass the puck (no shooting on net).
- Player may be forced to sit out a shift.
- The other team is awarded a penalty shot.
- The other team is awarded a goal.
- Player may be forced to sit out the remainder of the game.
- Player may be ineligible to play in next game
- Player may be suspended (game(s) or season).

In the event a player displays a deliberate action that has the potential to injure a fellow player, that player will be immediately removed from the ice for a period of time to be determined by the coach.

Depending upon the circumstances of the infraction, the player may be subject to the following:

- Ineligible to play the remainder of the game.
- Ineligible to play the remainder of the game, and the following game.

In the event a player’s deliberate actions result in injury to a fellow player, that player will be:

- Immediately removed from the ice for the remainder of the game.
- Suspended for a minimum of three (3) games.
- Potentially suspended for the season, upon review by the MSH Board

Remember the Golden Rule: Treat others as you wish to be treated.
