	Challenge-Up Program:			

-Skaters that enter an Adult "C" event may challenge only to Adult "B" age appropriate event.

-Skaters in any Adult "B" division may "challenge-up" to an age-appropriate "A" division and skate both divisions. -Skaters in any Adult "A" division may "challenge-up" to a Premier division and skate both divisions.

-Skaters who "challenge-up" and do not place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in the "challenged-up" division at the American Championships have the option to return to their age-appropriate division for the following season, unless they have placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in their age-appropriate division at the American Championships. (see move up rules) -When the official draw happens the solo events will skate the opposite dances from team. (If team draws group 2 for eliminations then solo will do group 1 for eliminations)
