DIVISION I ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS


To study and compete at a **Division I school**, you must earn 16 NCAA-approved **core-course credits**, earn a minimum 2.3 **core-course GPA** and submit your final transcript with proof of graduation to the Eligibility Center.

CORE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Earn 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits in the following areas:



4 years

For Division I, 10 of your 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits must be completed before the start of your seventh semester, including seven in English, math or science.







WHAT CAN WE DO NOW? 2. UNDERSTAND SOCIAL MEDIA

- YOUR SOCIAL MEDIA ACCOUNTS (ESPECIALLY TWITTER) ARE YOUR RESUME FOR RECRUITERS

 AND YOUR MAIN TOOL FOR PROMOTING YOURSELF
- FIRST PLACE RECRUITERS WILL TRY TO FIND YOU AND GET TO KNOW YOU
- ALSO USED FOR 1 TO 1 COMMUNICATION
- A FOLLOW OR DIRECT MESSAGE FROM A COACH IS A GOOD THING. THE EVALUATION PROCESS HAS BEGUN.
- ALWAYS FOLLOW BACK AND <u>CONSISTENTLY</u> COMMUNICATE WITH <u>ALL</u> COACHES WHO SHOW INTEREST

BIO SHOULD HAVE

- HIGH SCHOOL (SPELL IT OUT)
- GPA (ACT/SAT SCORES ALSÓ GOOD)
- C/O (CLASS OF) 2022, 2023, ETC. YOUR POSITION
- OTHER SPORTS AND ORGANIZATIONS
- HEIGHT/WEIGHT
- LIMIT USE OF EMOJIS IN BIO
- RANKINGS FROM 247, RIVALS, ESPN, ETC.







WHAT CAN WE DO NOW? 3. REACH OUT TO COACHES

- BEGIN FOLLOWING AND MESSAGING COACHES AT SCHOOLS YOU MIGHT BE INTERESTED IN
 - REMEMBER, IF YOU ARE CLASS OF 2025 OR YOUNGER, THEY CANNOT RESPOND DIRECTLY YET

WHAT CAN WE DO NOW? 4. PLAN FOR SUMMER CAMPS

• THE MAIN EVALUATION TOOL FOR MOST SCHOOLS IS SEEING YOU PERFORM IN PERSON AT CAMP
