Volunteer Hours

- 2 Hours per <u>Player</u>
- DIBS will be used for scheduling
- \$100 Volunteer Buy Out
- \$150 will be assessed for no buyout/no hours performed
- Volunteer Options for Concessions, Admissions, Raffle Assistance, etc.
- Board Members and Coaches (1 head & 1 assistant per team) exempt from volunteer hours



Fundraising

How it Works:

- Upon registration you are paying your required \$50 fundraising fee up front.
- You can recoup your funds by selling 5 calendars.
- You sell 5 calendars, keep the \$50 collected, and turn in only the calendars
- Your child can sell additional calendars for a chance to earn prizes.

Details By Grade Level

3rd Grade Details

- All teams are evenly split and playing time is equally divided.
- Jerseys will be purchased through 360 Apparel Jersey will be worn through 4th grade
- Practice will start mid- October and will be 2X per week 1-1.5 hour per practice
 - Typically earlier time slot
 - (10) "events" during the season
 - Games will start early November Details provided by coach

4th Grade Details

- All teams are evenly split and playing time is equally divided.
- Jerseys from last year will be used New players can purchase jerseys through 360 Apparel
 - Practice will start mid- October and will be 2X per week 1 hour per practice
 - (10) "events" during the season

Games will start early November Details provided by coach



5th/6th Grade Details

- Final teams are created after several weeks of practice.
- New jerseys will be purchased through 360 Apparel All 5th Grade Players and New 6th Grade Players Only
 - Practice will start mid-October Week and will be 2X per week
 - Games will start November 4th *Details provided by coach*





7th/8th Grade Details

Final teams are created after the first two weeks of practice.

Works around Middle School Ball season

Practice will be 2X per week - 1.5 hour per practice (After School Ball)

7th Grade Non-Parent Coach

Policy Details/Changes

6th – 8th Grade Attendance Policy

- Players are allowed and encouraged to engage in multiple sports/activities
- No player will be 'cut' or not allowed to play because of conflicts with other sports or activities

BUT

• Team placement or playing time may be affected by players missing Hoops Club practices and games in order to attend other events

Non – Club Sponsored Teams

- Allowed & encouraged BUT can not use the Hortonville Hoops name
- Teams are not sponsored by the Hortonville Hoops Program
- Formation of teams and selection of players/coaches are not monitored by the Hortonville Hoops Basketball program
- Clubs Insurance will not cover non sanctioned teams and teams formed outside of season
