  - 2:00 pm – 4:00 pm
  - Grades: 7 & 8
  - 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm
- ✓ Other dates:
  - **Pre-tryout clinic:** Thursday, September 6<sup>th</sup> from 6-7:30 pm Location TBD **Kent**, we can lead this unless you want to do this session?
  - **Travel Parent Meeting:** Thursday, September 13<sup>th</sup> MSW Cafeteria at 7:00 pm if available?
- ✓ Email to travel families to begin soliciting coaches – interviews will be the night of tryouts.
- ✓ Communication for tryouts

- ✓ Registration – Jim/Ryan
  - Goal begin August 1. End date Friday, September 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - Price \$325 includes tryout fee and Rochester (uniform not included.)
  - Increase in fees due to tournament prices are higher than last year.
- ✓ Evaluators – Kathy will work with Kent
  - Look at who we had last year.
- ✓ Uniforms
  - Tap into BSN rep to be at tryouts to help with orders
  - Orders will not be placed until teams are confirmed.

- ✓ Team formation and size:
  - Teams will be formed on or before Friday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.
  - At least 8 players per team and no more than 10 based on feedback from last year.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade – We will try not to cut if possible but still need to adhere to the numbers listed above.
  - 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> – Cutting expected to meet the numbers – alternative is STMA school basketball.
- ✓ Playing time:
  - 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> grade – As equal as possible
  - 7<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> grade – Not equal – 25% guaranteed playing time
- ✓ Volunteer Hours –
  - 6 hours for 1 child and 8 for 2 or more
- ✓ Coaches Interviews
  - Selection Committee will be identified
  - They will select and recommend coaches for board approval
  - Interviews will be conducted during travel tryouts.
