SGMHA Player Releases:

- 1. Attend the Spruce Grove Minor Hockey Association (SGMHA) U18 evaluation process which starts on Sept 26, 2021. Please refer to the SGMHA U18 Division home page for information regarding tiered evaluation, dates and location.
- 2. Request a second tryout at the U18AA Level. Contact U18AA Rep, Doug Petruk (dpetruk@eastlink.ca) of the Northern Alberta Hockey League (NAHL) and he will determine if there are other teams looking for players.

Non Resident Player Releases:

- 1. Released players will receive a release letter, along with the AA NTO that was submitted to the office during the tryout registration process.
 - If you do not receive the paperwork within 24 hours, please contact the SGMHA office (office@sgmha.ca) so they can be resent.
 - You will then return to your local minor hockey association (LMHA) to proceed with U18 tiered evaluations.
- 2. If you are interested in a second tryout at the U18AA Level, please contact U18AA Rep, Doug Petruk (dpetruk@eastlink.ca) NAHL and he will determine if there are other teams looking for players.
 - You will need to have the AA NTO and waiver from SGMHA office to forward to your next confirmed tryout.

Other Notes:

- Second tryouts at the AA level are not guaranteed. They are only granted if there is a request from another AA association.
- **SGMHA U18 Tiered Evaluations** are scheduled to begin Sept 26,2021. PAC team rosters will be finalized at the completion of the SSAC tournament.
- All Hockey Canada Rosters must be finalized as of Jan 10, 2022. Even though team rosters are formed in Sept, due to transactions and player movement in both the CJHL and WHL, the U18AAA team rosters may be impacted up until Jan 10, 2022 which may impact the PAC U18AA, U16AAA, U16AA teams.
