

CYFA March Board Meeting – 6/10/18

Notes:

- Weigh-in events are coming up on June 21st & July 11th – Laurie will send an email to confirm volunteers and times.
- National Flag Football worked out a deal with Community Education to use the High School turf field. We will be playing Sundays from early September to mid November.
- The registration fee for National Flag Football gives a \$20 profit that will be shared between Community Ed and CYFA - \$10 for each per registration.
- Head Coaches and Assistant Coaches need to take trusted coaching training before season; other Coaches that come after teams are formed need to take the training before the first game.
- Greg is going to email Diggins about getting the varsity players to officiate.
- Head Coaches will wear a lanyard at games to be easily identified and the point of contact for officials.
- Tackle wheels are in the shed; 11 small, 10 big. We will need to buy more footballs.
- Jeremy has been added to the bank account and should be getting a debit card in the next few days. He will pay the Comm Ed invoice as soon as he gets the card.
- Jeremy is in contact with Jared and will continue to transition the role. Jared is staying in touch until the insurance check clears, at a minimum.
- Jared sent the tax forms to Laurie, but they are in a platform that she can't access; Jeremy will work to get them reformatted and submitted to TRW Tax Services in Circle Pines.
- There is a 7th grade (league?) meeting on 7/22 at Broadway Pizza.
- It's likely that 7th grade games will be played on Sundays on the side turf due to good offer on field fees; checking on Community Ed's cancellation policy before committing to reservations.
- Greg sent an email to the coaches on 6/6 detailing upcoming events, dates, and requirements.
- As an alternate to the on-line coaches training, there will be an in-person USA Training session on 7/14 at the Viking's training facility in Eagan. Greg will send info when details are confirmed.
- Football clinics starting next week; Brad has a plan and will send out details. Currently, 71 are signed up; 27 for the 2nd – 4th grade & 44 for 5th – 7th grade

- DQ will be donating 10% of proceeds the night of the weigh-ins to CYFA. Need to have flyers and spread the word.
- Snap Fitness and Infinite Campus are potential sponsors – need to propose specific ideas to ensure it's the exposure the businesses want and how it benefits the kids/ program
- Still trying to find interest from food trucks – if you know anyone, please reach out.
