Coulee Alpine Racing Scoring for Pinski/Benjamin

Each athlete is placed in a category based on age (U8-U14) and gender (girls/boys). They receive points based on their finish place in their group for each of the 11 races. Here is how points are awarded based on finishes in their categories:

1^{st} = 25 points
2^{nd} = 20 \text{ points}
3^{rd} = 15 points
4^{th} = 12 points
5<sup>th</sup> = 11 points
6^{th} = 10 \text{ points}
7^{th} = 9 points
8^{th} = 8 points
7^{th} = 7 points
8^{th} = 6 points
9^{th} = 5 points
10^{th} = 4 points
11^{th} = 3 points
12^{th} = 2 points
13^{th} = 1 point
14th and under = 0 points
```

DNS (Did not start) = 0 points (DNS is given if a racer who did not attend the race).
DNF (Did not finish) = They are given a time of 399 and get the amount of points for their finish place. (DNF is given when a racer falls and is not able to finish the race).
DQ (Disqualified) = They are given a time of 299 and get the amount of points for their finish place. (DQ is given when a racer finishes the race, but missed a gate or went around the gate the wrong way).

We used a formula to add points from races. We eliminated the 4 worst point values in our calculation. This allows for athletes to miss some of the race days and still stay in medal contention.

The point system is taken from our high school race system. This is very similar to how your athlete will be individually scored if they join the high school program.

Each category will be separated and medals awarded in each for top finishers. We may award more medals in categories where we have lots of racers.

NOTE: Racers who are U12 and raced in the U14 category for the Spring Fling were awarded finish places based on how they finished in the U14 race. For this reason you may see more than one of any given place in the U12 category for this race and a places may be missing from U14 category.
