Format

Recurve/Barebow — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

- Juniors and Cadets: 40-cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10-ring scoring
- Cubs and Bowman: 60-cm target face; outer 10-ring scoring
- Collegiate and Adults: 40-cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) must use choice for entire tournament); outer 10-ring score

Compound Bow — One round of 60 arrows; 18 meters

 40-cm target face (choice of single-spot or vertical 3-spot face) — must use choice for entire tournament); inner 10-ring scoring

Requirements

Participants in the youth divisions for the JOAD State Indoor Championship must be members of a Minnesota JOAD club as well as a USA Archery member to compete for awards in this event. Other youth may participate as guests, but will not be eligible for awards.

Others are welcome to participate as guests, but will not be eligible for awards. To register in the collegiate division, archers must be from an official USA Archery collegiate archery program.

A membership in the MAA is required for any archer's score to be eligible for a state record.

The USA Archery dress code will be enforced.
