Agenda:

1. Team Selection

- a. Team Selection criteria used to determine teams was based on the number of coaches, pitchers, catchers, schools and we also tried to accommodate special requests as best we could. Our league is growing and keeping players grouped by their school is not always feasible.

2. Divisions

- a. **6U (5-6 year olds)**
 - i. The 6U division focuses on player development and having fun. It is important that players learn the basic skills of the game (throwing, batting, game rules, etc.). There will be one practice/game per week on Monday evening.
- b. **8U (7-8 year olds)**
 - i. The 8U is a developmental league. Focus is on beginning development of young players. Players will hit off the pitching machine for the first half of the season and pitchers will be incorporated in the 1st and 3rd innings as the season progresses. There will be one practice/game each week and will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a game on Tuesday evening. Games are 5 innings or 60 minute time limit (whichever comes first). Additional practice nights are determined by the team coaches.
- c. **10U (9-10 year olds)**
 - i. 10U will be competitive and keep score. Players will pitch every inning. Modified USA of ND rules will apply. There will be one practice/game each week and will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a game on Monday evening. Games are 7 innings or 90 minute time limit (whichever comes first). Additional practice nights are determined by the team coaches.
- d. **11Up (11-14 year olds)**
 - i. 11Up will be competitive following USA of ND rules and keep score. Players will pitch every inning. There will be one practice/game each week and will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a game on Wednesday evening. Games are 7 innings or 90 minute time limit (whichever comes first). Additional practice nights are determined by the team coaches.

3. Umpires

- a. 8U games - we ask the parents and coaches to umpire these games.
- b. Umpires will be provided for the 10U and 11Up leagues.
 - i. We allow area high school fastpitch players to umpire the 10U and 11Up leagues. This is a great learning opportunity for these older players and gives them a rare chance to view the game from a new and important perspective. Please be considerate of these girls as they are also learning.

4. Games

- a. 6U games will start on June 6th and run on Mondays for four weeks. Practice/game time is 5:45 pm at Cottonwood Park (north fields). There will be one practice/game per week which will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a 45 minute game.
- b. 8U games will start on June 7th and run on Tuesdays for six weeks. Practice/game time is 5:45 pm at Cottonwood Park (fastpitch fields). There will be one practice/game per week which will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a 5 inning or 60 minute (whichever comes first) game.
- c. 10U games will start on June 6th and run on Mondays for seven weeks. Practice/game time is 5:45 pm. There will be one practice/game per week which will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a 7 inning or 90 minute (whichever comes first) game.
 - i. **Week of July 4th, 10U division will play on Tuesday, July 5.**
 - ii. We will be using Cottonwood Park fastpitch fields and Ft. Lincoln Elementary School diamonds for league games. Schedules will be available via the Sports SignUp Play app once determined.
- d. 11up games begin on June 8th and run on Wednesdays for seven weeks. Practice/game time is 5:45 pm. There will be one practice/game per week which will consist of a 45 minute practice followed by a 7 inning or 90 minute (whichever comes first) game.
 - i. We will be using Cottonwood Park fastpitch fields and Ft. Lincoln Elementary School diamonds for league games. Schedules will be available via the Sports SignUp Play app once determined.

5. Practice

- a. Practice can start the week of May 29th. The practice schedule will be determined by the individual coaches. Please contact Scott Owens to schedule practice times - 701-400-7551.
- b. Practice plans have been developed to assist volunteer coaches during the 45 minute practices on game nights. Please use these plans as a guide and modify based on the needs of the team. Feel free to use the materials in your other practices.
