



Addison Ice is excited to move into the fall 2020 season, and continues to follow recommendations set forth by the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity.

Please do not come to the rink if you are experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever of 100.4 or above, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell or any other CDC-identified symptoms.

Please read and follow the rules and guidelines set forth for entering the Addison ice Arena:

As we continue under the Phase 4 State guidelines, we wanted to take this opportunity to inform our valued customers of the following changes in operating practices to deal with COVID-19 concerns:

1. We continue our reduction in capacity/occupancy for total persons in the building to 50% pursuant to Illinois DCEO mandates.
2. The Front Desk and Skate Rental areas have clear partitions installed to protect our guests and staff. Please respect those spaces for the safety of all.
3. All persons entering the rink must wear a face covering at all times except when engaging in an on-ice activity.
4. Please do not congregate at the front desk. Maintain the standard safe social distancing of six (6) feet. We will have taped standing markers on the floor for spacing guidance.
5. Hand Sanitizer stations will be located around the facility and we ask everyone to frequently use them.
6. There is no congregating in the Lobby area.
7. The Locker Rooms will be closed and no showers will be available. Chairs will be provided throughout the rinks for the purposes of putting on and taking off skates. Without locker room availability, please come as fully dressed as possible the rink and also please leave all valuables at home as there will not be a safe place to store them during your activity.
8. We will be restricting entry to the facility to: players/skaters, coaches, parents or guardians who must assist their player with getting ready and only a limited number of spectators in the stands if there is availability in the limited clearly marked safe seating spaces. If our limited spectator space is full, we ask that non-skaters and non-players remain outside and do not congregate at the entry door.
9. We will continue to monitor and regulate class instruction, numbers and distancing practices.
10. We ask that all players conduct their warm up activities outside whenever possible at a safe socially acceptable distance from each other.
11. Our staff will regularly be disinfecting the bathrooms so please be patient with us if such spaces are temporarily closed for cleaning.
12. We ask all persons in the building to maintain safe social distancing of six (6) feet between people per the CDC recommendations.
13. All water fountains will be unavailable for use so please be sure to bring your own filled water bottle and please do not share any water bottles between persons.
14. The Fifteen Minute Window – Please do not enter the rink earlier than 15 minutes prior to your ice session, and leave within 15 minutes after your ice session is finished, to allow proper time spacing & distancing.
15. The COVID-19 Waiver- All persons, without exception, will be asked to sign a COVID-19 Waiver, which is available for download on our website. If you are under eighteen (18) years of age, it must be signed by your parent or guardian as well. Please do this at home and bring to the rink prior to your ice session.
16. Please realize our staff will be doing everything to assure a safe facility for everyone who enters. As such, please understand that they will be monitoring the spacing situation on a regular basis and PLEASE comply with any requests they make. We all have to work together during this difficult time to make these necessary adjustments as painless as possible.
