Home Contest Policies (Fall) UPDATED 10/6/20

2020-21

With these unprecedented times and challenges we face because of the Covid-19 Pandemic, St. Thomas More Athletics is adjusting policies for home athletic contests. The goal as always is to keep our student-athletes safe. Procedures will be updated when needed or relaxed when advised by the South Milwaukee/St. Francis Health Department.

Spectator Policy

Volleyball (home game times this year changes to 4:15 for JV2, 5:30 for JV, and 7:00 pm for varsity)

- Volleyball players and coaches from the visiting team being able to purchase up to **TWO** admissions, and players and coaches from STM being able to purchase up to **FOUR** admissions.
- Admission will be \$5 per person. Children under 5 will be allowed in for free.
- All attendees will be required to check in at the admissions desk upon arrival and confirm which athlete is in their household.
- Once an athlete's maximum amount of family members in attendance, their name will be crossed off the check list.
- Attendees are encouraged to only stay for the game their family member is playing in.
- Each coach for both schools will receive two free admissions (show Metro Classic pass).
- School administrators will be allowed two free admissions (show Metro Classic pass).
- The bus driver for the visiting team will be allowed free admission.
- The conference commissioner will be allowed free admission.
- The concession stand will be open with bottled beverages and prepacked food items available.
- All spectators will be required to wear masks unless they are consuming items from the concession stand.

- STM hopes to gradually increase capacity, including the open a student section (based on capacity with six-foot social distancing).

Varsity Football (Played at St. Francis High School)

- Football player and coaches from the visiting school being able to purchase up to **TWO** admissions and STM players and coaches will be able to purchase up to **FOUR** admissions.
- Admission will be \$5 per person. Children under 5 will be allowed in for free.
- All attendees will be required to check in at the admissions desk upon arrival to confirm which athlete is in their household.
- Once an athlete's maximum amount of family members in attendance, that name will be crossed off the check list.
- Each coach for both schools will receive two free admissions (show Metro Classic pass).
- School administrators will be allowed two free admissions (show Metro Classic pass).
- The bus driver for visiting team will be allowed free admission.
- The conference commissioner will be allowed free admission.
- The concession stand will be open with bottled beverages and prepacked food items available.
- Per the St. Francis School District, all spectators are required to wear masks unless they are consuming items from the concession stand.
- STM hopes to gradually increase capacity, including the opening a student section (based on capacity with six-foot social distancing).

Varsity Soccer/JV Football (STM Soccer/Football Field off KK and Morgan Ave.)

- Seating for games at the will be limited to areas behind the end lines/end zones.
- Spectators are asked to six-foot social distance from each other.
- All spectators are encouraged to wear masks unless they are consuming food/beverage.
- Bringing lawn chairs is encouraged.

Tennis (STM Tennis Courts)/JV Soccer (Deer Creek)

- Spectators are asked to six-foot social distance from each other.
- All spectators are encouraged to wear masks unless they are consuming food/beverage.
- Bringing lawn chairs is encouraged.

Swim (Deer Creek)

It has been determined that the Deer Creek swim facility lacks the adequate size to run dual competitions even without fans. All swim meets this fall will take place at opponent's facilities.

Concessions Policy

- Workers: A maximum of two persons in the STM indoor and outdoor stands and four persons at the St. Francis stand with face coverings.
- All workers will wash/sanitize hands often.

- Customers should 6-foot social distance while waiting in line (markings will be made where available)
- Concession items will be limited to prepacked food and bottled beverages.

Gate ticket takers

- Ticket takers will wear face coverings.
- Admission will be \$5 per person. Children under 5 will be allowed in for free.
- All attendees will be required to check in at the admissions desk upon arrival to confirm which athlete is in their household.
- Once an athlete has his or her maximum amount of family members in attendance, their name will be crossed off the check list.

Game workers

All will wear face coverings – exception will be the PA Announcer (w/mic. cover).
