Coed State Tournament Rules

DEFENSE

- Outfield 2 men and 2 women
- Infield 2 men and 2 women
- Pitcher & catcher 1 man and 1 woman

BATTING ORDER

Alternate batting order by sexes.

GAMEPLAY

The home run limit in each division of the Coed State Tournament is as follows (with excess HRs being an out): Division 1 = 4, Divisions 2 & 3 = 2, and Division 4 = 0 (subject to review; to be resolved by April 2024)

If a man is walked, he is awarded two bases. If there are two outs, the next batter (female) has a choice of walking or hitting.

Teams are allowed one male and one female courtesy runner per inning. Additionally, the pitcher of record may have a courtesy runner any time that he or she is on base.

Extra Innings: The last player to bat in the previous inning will be placed on second base at the beginning of all extra innings. A courtesy runner may not be used in this instance.

PLAYER RATINGS FOR CLASSIFYING FOR COED STATE TOURNAMENTS

Class B – 7 points	Rec 1 – 4 points	Rec 4 – 1 point

DIVISION ALIGNMENT

Formula for determining divisions:

- Rate every player according to above chart.
- Top 5 men + top 5 women = total points
- Use total points to determine division from chart below.

Division 1	Division 2	Division 3
34-48 points	24-33 points	10-23 points

REC 1 & ABOVE PLAYERS ARE PROHIBITED FROM DIVISION 3. Teams within 3 points of another division are subject to being moved in order to get the nearest division to a minimum number of 4 teams. Teams with the closest point value are moved first. Additional teams will be moved only if needed. Player classification limits still apply.
