Minutes

- Agendas and meeting minutes from 8/21/22 were distributed and reviewed. A motion was made by Feltz, second by Kattre, to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed, 7-0

Financials

- Schrimpf provided board updated Financials and 2022-2023 budget for review. No major changes. Will continue to monitor and update as needed. Motion made by Younggren to approve budget as presented, second by Feltz. Motion passed 7-0.

2022-2023 Calendar

- Younggren provided updated calendar for 2022-23. Motion by Younggren to approve as presented, second by Wamsley. Motion passed 7-0.

2022-23 Registration

- Discussed upcoming deadlines for registration. (Travel closed on 9/14) Younggren shared where travel numbers were at compared to prior years. Up from last year and closer to 2019 levels. Highest numbers on girls travel in program history.
- Discussed upcoming parent meetings for Travel, need to promote and encourage attendance since 5th grade will now be tiered and increase in registrations.

Sponsorship

- Discussed the number of sponsors for 2022-23 (15); banners being printed and will be done in time for pickup prior to parent meetings. Younggren and Schrimpf will coordinate to track payments.

OYBL

- Group discussed and confirmed the scheduled dates for ½ grade programs. Group discussed placing signs on ball cages saying OYBL use only. Younggren will place on cages at schools prior to season.
- Group discussed registration, trending downward, but noted that typically late surge closer to deadline should have numbers up from last year and more toward projections.

Travel

- Group discussed evaluation dates and times. Agreed to move boys times back 30 minutes to accommodate 5th grade. Confirmed alternate evaluations. Discussed Board members signup to help check-in at evaluations.
- Group discussed where the current numbers are, noted there will likely be some grades with 3 teams and other grades where referrals will occur due to odd numbers. Younggren will notify HS AD just to keep them in the loop of possible referrals.
- Discussed new uniforms that have been ordered with new OCB logo.

School District

- Mr. Heitz shared that gym reservations and policies are being evaluated and policy to come in future. Indicated that a group of 3rd grade players have requested gym space, wanted to confirm that will not interfere with OYB gym space and is not part of OYB programming.
- Board again discussed possible need to evaluate expanding travel program to 3rd grade in future.
