Dear Parents,

Highlands field is completely volunteer run. That means there is no help from the city, county and very little from the school board. Without volunteer there will be no Highlands. That being said, each player will have two (2) dates assigned to them, these can be filled by parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, even teenage siblings. The first will be for concession duty, you will either be inside the concession stand or working the grill. The second will be one of the following three (3) things: P.A. Game Announcer, Scoreboard Keeper, Trash Duty (we have a handy dandy trash grabber) trash duty could possibly be done during practice time.

If a volunteer for a player doesn't show up for concession duty, game balls will not be handed to the Umpire and that players team will forfeit the game.

If a volunteer doesn't show for one of the other positions, the player will have to sit out that game.
