At an early age, **Philip Neri** moved from Florence to Rome and devoted his life to God. After three years of studying theology, he gave up the thought of being ordained, and decided he would serve the Church and people as a layperson. Thirteen years later, at the urging of his confessor, Philip was ordained a priest. He was an outstanding confessor himself, as he was able to lead his penitents in a loving way, often with a joke, to let down their guard and make an honest confession. He arranged talks, discussions, prayers and excursions which often included music, food and joy! Many people wrongly assumed that Philip could not possibly be a spiritual, holy person while also finding so much fun and enjoyment in his life. He reminds us to embrace our humanness while also striving for holiness.
